

What is "Power of Attorney"? A Power of Attorney ("POA") is a legal document one uses to appoint another person to act of his/her behalf. A "grantor" or "principal" describes the person who has executed the power of attorney. The person given the fiduciary responsibility to act in the best interests of the principal is called an "attorney in fact" or "agent."


Durable POAs enable the agent to act for the principal even after the principal is not mentally competent or physically able to make decisions.

When utilizing a POA, agents will need to indicate that they're acting under a power of attorney. Agents will sign their own name after the principal's name, after including the word "by." Agents will also need to end the

signature by writing the word "agent," "attorney in fact," or "POA" after their name. For example, a final signature should read similar to "Sally Smith, by John Smith, POA."

POAs may be revoked at any time. Principals have the responsibility of notifying their agent and also their financial institution that a POA has been revoked. All powers of attorney automatically expire upon death of the principal.

Financial institutions have a fiscal responsibility to carefully review every POA to determine the type and duties granted in the document. For more information concerning POAs, we recommend consulting with legal counsel.
