Summer brings sunshine, BBQs and an urge to get away. But as you dive into the summer season, don't forget your finances! Here's how to give your money a thorough checkup to prepare for a great summer and beyond.

Check your credit report's health

Late payments, identity theft and reporting errors in credit reports can ruin your credit score, affecting everything from how much

a car loan costs you to whether you can buy a house. By monitoring your credit regularly, you can identify problems early. Go to AnnualCreditReport.com or call 877-322-8228 to get your free annual report from each of the three national credit bureaus. Your credit scores come separately, but you can buy them from the bureaus for a small fee.

Some financial institutions, like Ticonderoga Federal Credit Union, offer free financial checkups. Typically, they'll explain the things that credit bureaus consider in determining Continued on back »

a contract that will
save the credit union
approximately \$1.5M over
the next seven years. In
conjunction with this new

agreement, we are in the process of implementing several new products and services and upgrading many others.

"You'll love what's new at TFCU".....

As I reminded the attendees at our Annual Meeting in early May, our field of membership includes all of Essex and Washington Counties as well as the towns of Horicon and Chester in Warren County here in New York. We want and need to position the credit union to remain financially viable, relevant and accessible now, and in the years to come, so that existing and potential members view TFCU as your / their primary financial institution. We need to do so as efficiently and cost effectively as possible which is why we are making a significant investment in upgraded and new technology. The world we live in turns on technology. Consumers live their lives with and access products and services using various forms of technology and quite frankly expect it. We intend to meet that expectation.

Updating existing and introducing new technology will help lay the necessary foundation so that whether from your front porch, on your college campus, wintering in Florida or traveling in Chicago, San Francisco or Dublin Ireland, TFCU will be where you are.

I am pleased to share with you several new products and services in various stages of production due to be introduced this year. Specifically:

Internet Banking and Bill-Pay: We will replace our existing Virtual Branch internet banking and bill-pay products with new more streamlined products. You will be able to access both new products with single sign-on access so there will be no need for two separate ID's and passwords for these products. With this ease of access and with a cleaner look and more intuitive design, your home banking / bill payment experience will be much improved.

Popmoney: Within the internet banking / bill pay product, Popmoney will allow you to use your smart phone

to send money to anyone with a mobile number or e-mail address. You will also be able to request money from an individual or group.

Account Aggregation: The new internet banking product will include account aggregation capability which will enable you to import data from other online accounts, creating a complete financial portrait across all of your online accounts within your TFCU internet banking profile.

Account Create: We will introduce Account Create which in conjunction with Web / Electronic Signature will enable you and potential members to complete applications online without the need to visit a branch location.

Web / Electronic Signature: We will offer a secure way for you to electronically sign forms and securely return required documentation, such as payroll stubs and insurance information, enhancing your ability to apply for and receive a loan much more efficiently and quickly without the need to visit a branch location.

Smart Phone App: We are also working on mobile apps for both iPhone and Android users to make it easier to conduct business with TFCU wherever you are.

Remote Deposit Capture: Using a downloadable app, you will be able to use your smartphone's camera to snap a picture of the front and back of each check, and then submit the images electronically to TFCU for deposit into your account.

Instant Issue Debit Cards: We will soon have the ability to instantly replace your debit card should it be lost or stolen, or to provide one for new account holders at account opening. We will also provide the opportunity for you to customize your card with an image of your choosing.

These are exciting times at TFCU! These new products and services represent necessary change. We are making this change because of our unchanging commitment to quality service to you. Doing so will allow us to serve you better but as importantly, we hope it confirms for you and potential members that TFCU is financially strong, relevant and accessible. Yes, we think "you'll love what's new at TFCU" so please stay tuned for more information about these new products and services in the weeks to come!

your score, and they'll go through your report and discuss things that appear to be affecting your credit standing.

A financial checkup is also likely to look at whether other options, such as consolidating debt or refinancing your home, might be worthwhile.

Bolstering an anemic credit score

One strategy for rebuilding credit is

taking out a secured share credit card. With a secured card, you deposit enough money to cover the limit you're applying for, and your financial institution keeps that amount on hold for as long as you have the card. A secured card lets you establish a record of responsible credit use and of consistently making timely payments ---boosting your credit

standing in the process.

Tackling costly debt

High interest debt from credit cards and loans can easily spiral out of control. To lower interest rates and reduce monthly payments, consider looking into debt consolidation, which combines debt from multiple sources into a single lender. Choose from a number of solutions including home equity loans and lines of credit as well as personal loans.

With mortgage rates still near historic lows, those holding older mortgages might also benefit from refinancing to get a lower-interest loan.

Tuning up your credit score and tidying up your debts can refresh your finances. Before you know it, your budget will be in healthier shape, and you'll be able to afford more summer fun.
